AMR Takes Local Seniors Home for the Holidays ***Ambulance Provider Provides Gift of Family to Two Local Elderly Women***

San Diego, CA (December 28, 2007) – Two skilled nursing home patients in Chula Vista celebrate Christmas with loved ones at their family homes, thanks to a holiday goodwill project from American Medical Response (AMR) ambulance service.

With the project called Home for the Holidays, AMR donates roundtrip ambulance service in the holiday season for selected nursing home patients to and from their family residences. Fredericka Manor skilled nursing facility in Chula Vista selected the participating patients earlier this month.
